


Kids Corner

Operation Christmas Child (OCC) is a way we can "Give of ourselves so others may know Jesus Christ". Since 1993, OCC has provided gift boxes to more than 232 million children in over 170 countries. The boxes are distributed at Gospel-focused outreach events. With each box,

children receive a book called <u>The Greatest Gift</u> which tells the story of the Gospel. They are also invited to attend "The Greatest Journey" discipleship program which includes 12 Bible lessons. The children share what they've learned with friends and family, and more people put their faith in Christ. Every shoebox shares the good news of Jesus Christ! Pick up your box at the network table starting October 19th. Here are some tips for filling a quality box:

Make it fun – include a quality "Wow" gift!

Make it full – if it rattles, it's not full.

Personalize it with a note letting children know that God loves them.

Include the \$10 donation to cover the shipping costs. This can be done online.

All liquids, including toothpaste, and food/candy are strictly prohibited. Please do not include them as they will be discarded.

Please put an OCC label on your box indicating whether it is for a boy or girl, and what age group.

The deadline to have your boxes at Bethlehem Church, Dallastown, so that they can make it to their next destination is Sunday, November 16th at the worship services.

HARVEST HOME – Sunday November 16, 2025



The generous will themselves be blessed, for they share their food with the poor. Proverbs 22:9

On Sunday, November 16th the Altar n Flower Guild together with the Children's Department, will sponsor Harvest Home Sunday. Church members are invited to bring food donations and place them at the altar.

For many years, Harvest Home Sunday donations helped stock the church pantry, supporting those in need in our community. However, due to the challenges brought by COVID in 2020, both Harvest Home Sunday and the pantry were discontinued.

This year, all food donations will be given to 2 organizations: Community Reach in Red Lion, to assist with Thanksgiving meals for those in the community experiencing hardship and Our Daily Bread in York City. This organization provides meals for those in need 5 days a week, including holidays. In 2024, Our Daily Bread served 11,000 more meals than in 2023.

Following church services on November 16th, donations will be taken to Wesley Hall, sorted, and boxed for delivery to both organizations.


Details about needed food items and other specifics will be shared in the coming weeks. We ask everyone to consider donating to support those experiencing hardship.


